The Youth Centre is located at the Riverbank of River Kuron, on the west side of the river, opposite Peace Village compound.

The location is shadowed by huge trees, which stays ever green, even when the river dries up during dry season.

The main building at Youth Centre - used in 2015 as base for the training of women/girls in tailoring.




The more temporary guesthouses at Youth Centre, where preparations are done early January 2016 for transforming the 5 houses into permanent buildings.
