

## **Rehabilitation of St. Thomas Primary School Kuron-Sudan.**

Lack of and poor school infra structure remains big progressive hindrances in school performance and development. Much interference is experienced in these localities faced with such hindrances. Rainfall, storms causing a lot of dust, animal interference in pastoral areas especially when school fence is lacking and heat in the semi-arid and arid areas. Pupils' morale for education not only has been lowered but performance affected as a result. However these hindrances are yet to become history in Kuron after the completion of 8 classrooms building, with administration block and pupils kitchen. The existing old school building with three classrooms shall be converted into a dormitory for the pupils who trek from over 50 to 100 km away from kuron.
