

## His Lordship, Bishop Paride Taban

Born on 1936 by Abraham Alokwe Kenyi and Sara Mude Androga Druku in Lomura (Opari). He grew up in Katire (Imotong Mountains) from 1940 - 1949 and had his Elementary school 1 - 3. In 1950 he had Elementary 4 School at Loa Mission. After which he applied to join the Minor Seminary at Okaru. He was accepted in 1951-1956 trained at the Seminary. When he completed the Minor Seminary. He continued his Studies at the Major Seminary in Tore (Yei) in 1957-1963. He was made a Sub-Deacon at Rejaf Mission on February 1964. The same Year he was ordained a Deacon at Busere Way on the Feast of Holy Trinity 1964 and a Priest on the 24th May 1964 by His Lordship, Bishop Ireneo Dud at St. Theresa Cathedral in Kator, Juba. On the 15th June 1964. He was appointed a Rector of Minor Seminary in Okaru. From Okaru, he took refuge to Juba in November 1965. He was put under House Detention from December 1965 to February 1966. He was freed from House Detention with Fr. Augustino Oboma and they began to build St. Mary minor Seminary in Juba from 1966 to December 1968. He was appointed a Parish Priest of Torit Mission from 1969 to 1972. He was transferred from Torit Mission and appointed a Parish Priest of Palotaka Mission from 1973 -1976. He was transferred from Palotaka Mission and appointed a Parish Priest of Loa Mission from 1977 -1980. Because of his hard work and a well known Priest in Agriculture. He was elected to be the First Priest President of Torit Cooperative Union from 1977 to 1980 as well. This was like a Door Opening for Bishop Paride Taban. The same year he was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Juba Archdiocese and consecrated by Pope John Paul II in Kinshasa, Congo on 4th May 1980. When The Dioceses of Torit was created, he was transferred there to be The First Bishop. He took Official Charge of The Diocese on the 7th August 1983 to February 2004. From March 2004 up-to-date, Bishop Paride Taban is now Founder of Holy Trinity Peace Village - Kuron in The Republic of South Sudan.
